

New Oil to Gas Conversion Burner? What to expect!

First, our team will schedule an assessment with you so our technician can determine if you are a candidate for a conversion to gas. Once an approved candidate, there are several changes that must be made to ensure a safe, efficient, and reliable system for home for years to come.

During the assessment, the chimney will be evaluated to determine if it needs to be sleeved with a stainless-steel liner. This liner not only preserves the integrity of the chimney and allows for modern burners to work properly, it is also a CT Inspector requirement. You will also need to have your boiler cleaned prior to the Hubbell burner installation. Mainly the firebox: as the exhaust and byproducts of oil combustion could create damage to the new conversion burner and other components of your heating system. Then once the boiler is cleaned Hubbell can schedule the installations and YES, your chimney will also be cleaned as part of the liner service!

Since gas exhaust from combustion is much cleaner your unit may require less servicing and may also run potentially quieter. This is normal and the operation of your appliance as well as your existing controls (thermostats/relays) shall go unchanged.
